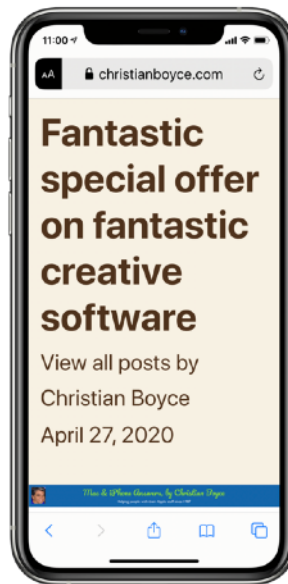

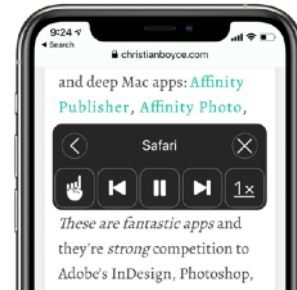

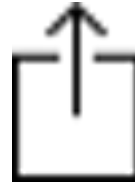

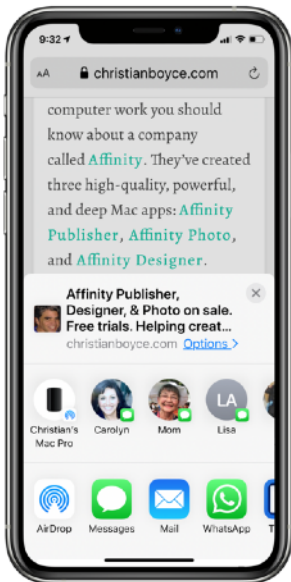

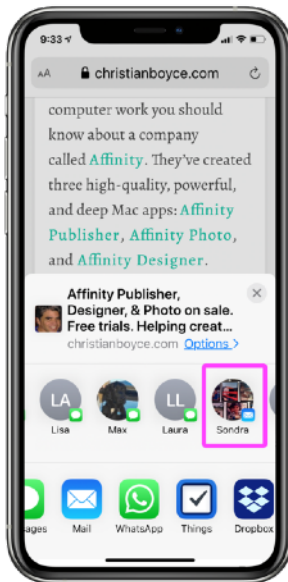

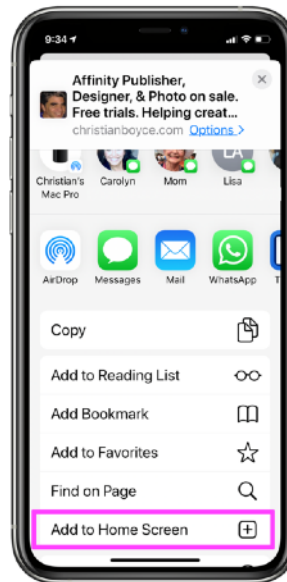
Ordinary Share panel

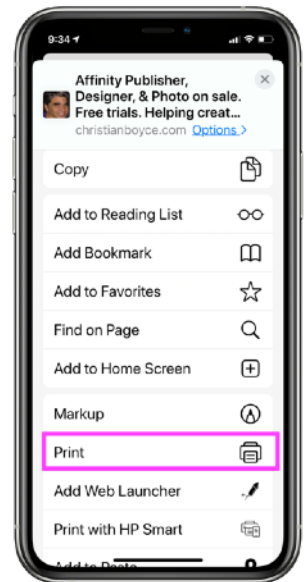
Share panel showing it remembers how you share
